Both the rooftop sukkah and the 5th floor sukkah are open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Ansche Chesed provides paper goods and coffee and tea, but no other beverages.

Meals in the sukkah must conform to Ansche Chesed's kashrut policy: *Only dairy or parve foods prepared in a kosher kitchen or packaged kosher products are permitted. No meat is allowed in the sukkah.*
